Recycling Containers

There are no separate recycling containers in Auburn. The materials in your trash are sorted at the Materials Recovery Facility where the recyclables are removed and recycled. Place trash and recyclables in your single container and we will sort it out!

Containers and Collection

Large 96-gallon trash and greenwaste containers are provided and maintained by **Recology Auburn Placer**. Standard 32-gallon containers are provided by the customer. Collection for all materials happens on the same day but not necessarily the same time.



Gray for Trash

- * Select service: 32- or 96-gallon container. 32-gallon provided by customer. 96-gallon provided by **Recology Auburn Placer**.
- * Additional 96-gallon containers available for an extra charge.
- * Refuse above top of container or bags placed on the side of the container will be collected and charged extra.
- * **No dirt, sod, rocks, concrete; large debris from remodeling, construction, or demolition; toxic or flammable materials such as oil, gas, paint; TVs, fluorescent tubes, or tires.**
- * Weight limits: 32-gallon=50 pounds, 96-gallon=180 pounds.




Green for Greenwaste

- * Available only with 96-gallon trash service.
- * Greenwaste only. Use for leaves, grass clippings, weeds, tree or shrub prunings.
- * Please cut tree and shrub prunings small enough to fit inside the container.
- * Lids must be closed.
- * **No trash or recyclables.**
- * **No hazardous waste, bags, lumber, dirt or rocks.**

Proper Cart Placement for Collection

Please leave 5' of clearance around carts



- Place container out by 5:00 AM or the night before. We guarantee a pickup day; we do not guarantee a time.

- To prevent spillage, please place all extra bags in or beside your container. All extra material must be bagged.
- Hot ash or coal should never be placed in the container. Cold ash or coal must be bagged.
- Cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed in bundles no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet (that will allow the boxes to fit inside container).
- We are not responsible for goods or articles in or near refuse container.
- Make sure that there is a safe amount of room between containers. Please make sure that no container is closer than five feet from any car or other obstacle.
- Do not block sidewalks with containers.

Additional Programs and Services

Electronic Waste Recycling

E-waste includes TVs, computers, radios, phones, etc. and may not be disposed of in the trash. Please recycle e-waste at the **Recology Auburn Placer Transfer Station** for no extra charge.

Recology Auburn Placer (RAP) will also collect e-waste at your curbside for no extra charge. Contact us to schedule a pickup.

Blue Bag Recycling

Blue bags offer another way to recycle. Blue bags are collected at no extra charge and are available from **RAP**. Please call our office to request bags.

Place approved recyclables in your bag, tie, and leave inside your trash container or beside it on collection day. Acceptable items include all types of:

- Paper
- Glass & Plastic - lids removed
- Metals

1-Yard Trash Disposal

This is a once-a-year service for Auburn residents. Up to one cubic yard of materials may be set out at curbside for no extra charge. E-waste, appliances, furniture, and other items may not be included. Watch your bill or check the City's website for the announcement of the date for the 1-Yard Trash Disposal event.

Oil, Oil Filter & Battery, Door to Door Collection

Just set out sealed jugs of motor oil, sealed bags with oil filters, and used auto batteries at your doorstep and we will take them to be recycled. Customers must use the jugs and bags that are provided by **Recology Auburn Placer** and must call to schedule a pickup. We will collect your full oil jugs and filter bags and leave empty ones. Call for information or to receive supplies to get started.

Consumer type batteries are also collected. Just place them into clear zip-lock bags at your doorstep for collection.

Fats, Oil & Grease, Door to Door Collection
Recology Auburn Placer and the City of Auburn now provide a free fats, oils, and grease (FOG)

collection. Contact us to schedule a pickup. Pickups can occur as often as once a month.

Christmas Tree Recycling

Auburn residents may drop off their Christmas trees for no extra charge between December 26 and January 31 at the **Recology Auburn Placer Transfer Station**. Remove all tinsel, lights, ornaments, and stands. Flocked trees will not be accepted for recycling and should be cut up and placed in the gray trash container.

There are many temporary free drop-off locations throughout Auburn and Placer County. Call for details.

Daily Drop-Off

Certain items are accepted year-round at the **Recology Auburn Placer Transfer Station** during normal business hours. Items include:

- Fluorescent light tubes
- Motor oil and filters
- Latex paint
- Household & automotive batteries
- Cooking oil, fats, oil & grease
- Sharps (needles & lancets). Place sharps in a rigid plastic container.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

HHW is illegal to dispose of in your trash container. HHW can be disposed of at no additional charge at the Western Placer Waste Management Authority HHW Facility in Lincoln. This facility, located at 3033 Fiddymont Road near Roseville, is open daily from 8 AM to 5 PM and can be reached by calling 916-645-5230x4 or by clicking wpwma.com.
