



ADA Phase II Public Outreach

The City of Auburn is in the process of reviewing Phase II of its ADA Transition Plan (the Plan), which includes a self-evaluation and transition plan for City public rights of way, City parking lots, and City owned parks. The Plan will be used as a guide for making physical improvements to facilitate accessibility in the public right of way, City parking lots, and City owned parks for persons with disabilities.

The Plan is being reviewed after completing a field survey of existing facilities, to determine the areas that are not in compliance with applicable accessibility standards. The Plan also outlines a strategy for making improvements considering several factors such as the extent of deficiencies, identified needs, proximity to certain facilities, requests and complaints by the community, available budget and scheduling.

The City of Auburn would like any suggestions or comments on its proposed Plan. The City will consider any comments received by October 1, 2020 and all comments received will be evaluated for inclusion in the Plan prior to its adoption.
