### DOWNLOAD

The TransLoc App is available for Android and iOS

### EXPLORE TRANSIT

TransLoc App is your portal to explore both fixed route and on-demand transit services available in your area. Click the OnDemand option located at the bottom of the screen.

### FIND SERVICES

Available services will be shown along with their daily schedule, fare (if applicable), and service area.

### BOOK A TRIP

Once you provide an Origin and Destination, the TransLoc app will provide an estimated drop-off window.

### LOG IN

You will be asked to create an account the first time you use the service.

### TRACK YOUR RIDE

The TransLoc App will keep you updated with your arrival estimate. Follow your assigned vehicle in real time all the way through to your destination.

### Transfers

Auburn Transit's fares include a free transfer within  
Auburn Transit, or to and from Placer County Transit  
and Gold Country Stage.

Placer County Transit's fares and passes  
include a free transfer to Roseville Transit or  
Auburn Transit. PCT accepts transfers from  
Sacramento Regional Transit and Gold Country  
Stage.

Roseville Transit's fares include a free transfer within  
Roseville Transit. Roseville Transit's passes allow for  
free transfer to and from Sacramento Regional  
Transit and Placer County Transit.

## 3 ENJOY YOUR RIDE

### A Few Rules

Eating is not permitted on board and beverages must have  
screw-top lids. Pets, other than service animals, are not  
permitted. Passengers may only bring as many bags or carry-  
ons as they can safely carry in one trip.

### Priority Seating

Seats at the front of the bus are considered priority seating for  
seniors and passengers with disabilities. Please keep these  
seats open or move if a senior or person with a disability  
boards.

#### 30 RIDE PASS

General Public ..... \$36.00  
\*Senior/\*\*Disabled/Youth ..... \$18.00

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General Public ..... \$60.00  
\*Senior/\*\*Disabled/Youth. .... \$30.00

### ONDEMAND/CONFLUENCE ROUTE FARES

General Public: ..... \$3.50  
\*Senior/\*\*Disabled/Youth. .... \$1.75

### ONDEMAND PASSES

#### 30 RIDE PASS

General Public ..... \$90.00  
\*Senior/\*\*Disabled/Youth ..... \$45.00

### Transfers

Only excepted on the Auburn Loop service.

\*Seniors: 60 and Older, Youth 6–18, Children under Age 5 Free (Up to  
two children under age 5 may ride free with each fare-paying adult.)

\*\*Disabled: Proof of eligibility required.

### Bikes On Board

Bikes ride free on Placer County Transit, Roseville Transit, Auburn  
Transit, and Capitol Corridor. Space is limited and first-come first-  
served.

### ADA Accessibility

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ensures that all services  
and facilities are accessible to all citizens, regardless of age or  
physical limitation. All buses in Placer County are fully accessible and  
transit providers also offer paratransit services. To request paratransit  
service call (916 or 530) 745-7560 or 888-745-7885 for TTY.

### Transit Ambassadors

Transit Ambassadors are trained to assist passengers with disabilities  
and provide information about transit services. They are available on  
all transit routes and can be contacted at (916 or 530) 745-7560 or  
888-745-7885 for TTY.

### Mobility Training

Mobility Training is a program designed to help passengers with  
disabilities learn how to use transit services. It includes information  
about boarding and exiting the bus, as well as how to use the
