


Annabell McCord

Annabell was born in Iowa. She married Glen McCord as a high school senior. They started a floor covering business and raised two sons. In addition, they fostered sixteen other children. Annabell was involved in community service in Auburn for over forty years. Her list of contributions to the community is extensive. She helped organize the Auburn Hot Line, and served on the Commission to Aid Retarded Children. She served on the Auburn Area General Plan Advisory Committee. She was elected to the Placer County Charter Commission and was appointed to the Auburn Planning Commission and to the League of California Cities Environmental Quality Control Committee. She was influential in the Soroptimist Club and the Business and Professional Women's Organization. The annual Celebrity Chefs Cooking for Community Service was started by Annabell. She served on the Auburn City Council and was Mayor. She won the McCann Award for her dedication to the Auburn community.
