<b>SUBJECT:</b>	AB481 Military Equipment Report

On September 30, 2021, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 481 (AB 481) into law, establishing Government Code Sections 7070 through 7075. This legislation governs the acquisition and use of military equipment by California law enforcement agencies. Under AB 481, law enforcement agencies must obtain approval from their governing body prior to requesting, funding, acquiring, using, or collaborating in the use of any military equipment, as defined in Government Code Section 7070.

In accordance with AB 481, the Auburn City Council adopted an ordinance and corresponding policy on June 13, 2022, authorizing the Auburn Police Department to fund, acquire, and utilize specified military equipment, subject to continued City Council oversight and approval.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 7072, the Auburn Police Department is required to submit an Annual Military Equipment Report to the Auburn City Council and make the report publicly accessible via the Department's official website. The report must include detailed information about each category of military equipment authorized by the City Council and is intended to promote transparency, accountability, and community engagement.

The purpose of this report is to provide the Auburn community with the opportunity to review the Department's use of approved military equipment in advance of the formal submission to the City Council, scheduled for the regular session on June 23, 2025. In addition, an informational community meeting will be held on June 18, 2025, in the Rose Room at City Hall, 1225 Lincoln Way, Auburn, CA. This meeting is open to the public and will provide an opportunity to ask questions and receive clarification regarding the report and the use of military equipment.
