2 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING NEW RULES OF OPERATING PROCEDURES RELATING  
3 TO THE TRAFFIC COMMITTEE.

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4 THE AUBURN CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE THE FOLLOWING REGARDING  
5 THE  
6 TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

7 **GOAL.**

8 The goal of the Traffic Committee is to suggest the most practicable means for coordinating  
9 the activities of all officers and agencies of the city having authority with respect to the  
10 administration or enforcement of traffic regulations Auburn while serving in an advisory  
11 capacity to the City Council in such matters.

12 **RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TRAFFIC COMMITTEE.**


13 The Traffic Committee shall have the following responsibilities:

- 14 (A) To stimulate and assist in the preparation and publication of traffic reports;  
15 (B) To receive complaints having to do with traffic matters; and  
16 (C) To recommend to the Council, the Traffic Engineer, the Police Chief and other city  
17 officials ways and means for improving traffic conditions and the administration  
18 and enforcement of the traffic regulations  
19 (E) Submit an annual budget in May of each year for approval by the City Council.  
20 (The City Council must approve the budget prior to expenditure.); and return in  
21 January of each year to provide a mid-year status update.  
22 (F) Follow the rules of operating procedures as outlined in "Exhibit A".


23 **COMMITTEE MEMBER APPOINTMENTS, TERMS AND VACANCIES.**

24 (A) The Committee shall be composed of the Traffic Engineer, the Police Chief, and  
25 the Director of Public Works or representatives of unofficial bodies as may be determined  
26 and appointed by the Mayor. The Mayor will appoint one (1) Council Member to serve a  
27 one-year term on the committee. The Chairperson of the Committee shall be appointed by  
28 the Mayor and may be removed by him or her. The Chairperson of the Traffic Committee  
must rotate annually.


