2 A RESOLUTION OF THE AUBURN CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE CITY
3 CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE POLITICAL
4 REFORM ACT OF 1974

6 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS
7 FOLLOWS:

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9 **WHEREAS**, the Political Reform Act requires the City Council, as the
10 code review body, to conduct a biennial review of the City's Conflict of Interest
11 Code, and

12 **WHEREAS**, employment positions have been added, eliminated, or
13 renamed since the current code was adopted, and

14 **WHEREAS**, the City Clerk has provided proper notice to the City Council
15 of said review and has recommended certain changes to the City's Conflict of
16 Interest Code, and

17 **WHEREAS**, the City has held any required public hearings upon proper
18 notice,

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as follows:

20 1. The City has determined that the following employment positions
21 with the City of Auburn have been deleted: Director of Public Safety, Fire
22 Division Chief, Oversight Board to Successor Agency.

23 2. In addition, the City Council desires to further amend the City's
24 Conflict of Interest Code to include on Exhibit A the positions of Police Chief
25 and Fire Chief. Exhibit A and Exhibit B as attached to this Resolution are
26 hereby incorporated and adopted by this reference as if fully set forth herein.

27 3. The Political Reform Act (Government Code section 81000, et seq.)
28 ("PRA") requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate

1 conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") has
2 adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations section 18730) that
3 contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be
4 incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing,
5 the standard code may be amended by the FPPC to conform to amendments in
6 the PRA. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations
7 section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the FPPC are hereby
8 incorporated by reference, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto
9 as Exhibit C. These regulations and the attached Exhibits, designating positions
10 and establishing disclosure requirements, shall constitute the City's Conflict of
11 Interest Code.

12 Individuals holding designated positions shall file their statements of
13 economic interest with the City Clerk, which will make the statements available
14 for public inspection and reproduction pursuant to Government Code section
15 81008. City Councilmembers, City Attorney, City Manager, City Treasurer, and
16 Planning Commissioners shall file their statements of economic interest with
17 the City Clerk, which will make and retain copies and forward the originals to
18 the FPPC. All other statements shall be retained by the City Clerk.

19 4. The City Clerk shall file a statement with the Fair Political Practices
20 Commission that the City's Conflict of Interest Code has been amended in the
21 above respect.


22 5. This Resolution repeals and replaces any and all previous
23 Resolutions of the City Council adopting or amending the City's Conflict of
24 Interest Code.
